MYSTERIOUS DISEASES OF SUMMER

At Magical Ranch, we've had a cluster of horsey problems due to summertime conditions. Even though we are watchful for summer sores, it seems like they are always lurking and ready to erupt. Horses, after all, are large animals that get their share of scrapes, cuts, and have big mucous membranes. All those areas can attract that nasty little worm, most likely carried by flies, and cause a major eruption. The centerlines of horses are susceptible. We do a weekly check of all the horses' centerlines. Those centerlines can have scabs, and be a great entry for pigeon fever. So we put Vasoline or SWAT on any sore we find, and are sorely tempted to put it on every horses' centerline. We use Repel-x cream, too, on ears (inside and out), around eyes, around noses and mouths. I have been known to line up the fly masks, and put fly spray on all the fuzzy parts. It's really not so different from the fly sheets that come permeated with insect repellent.

Bottom line on sores is that they need to be cleaned, medicated, and covered completely. Mucous membranes are another very attractive area for flys to deposit those little worms that lay eggs and cause summer sores. The corner of the eye, corners of the mouth, the sheath on male horses – I've seen



summer sores on all of those, and they are especially hard to heal. There are specific wormers that target these summer sore carriers. Two of them are Quest Plus and ivermectin. My vet swears by Quest Plus used in April, and followed by ivermectin in June. Another area to watch is the lower legs – they can easily start getting nasty insect bites. Repel-x cream works, too – a handful run up and down the lower leg to the top of the hoof will keep the nasties away. In winter we long for summer, and then all these nasties appear, so we are eager to have winter return.






FUZZY WUZZY HORSE SHOW RULES

COVID-19 RULES AND PROTOCOLS

The Fuzzy Wuzzy Show being sponsored by the Motherlode Arabian Horse Association and will follow all local, state, and county rules regarding social distancing, the wearing of face masks, and frequent washing of hands.

Hand sanitizing stations are widespread on the grounds and we ask that exhibitors wear face masks when within 6 feet of others and or approaching the food facilities, horse show office, and ribbon table. Additionally, those who wish to spectate we ask that you wear a mask at all times when ringside. All persons entering the grounds MUST sign required waiver forms.

- 1. USEF RULES ARE TO APPLY EXCEPT WHERE OTHERWISE NOTED.
- RIDING APPAREL –ENGLISH/WESTERN RIDERS MUST WEAR BOOTS & LONG SLEEVE SHIRTS & HATS AND OR HELMETS. HELMETS (ASTM APPROVED) REQUIRED IN ENGLISH EQUITATION CLASSES FOR ALL AGES AND HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR ALL RIDERS WHILE RIDING ON THE COMPETITION GROUNDS. CHAPS AND HUNT COATS ARE OPTIONAL.
- 3. JUNIOR HORSE is one that is 5 years and under.
- 4. MAIDEN Horse or Rider that has not won 1ST place ribbons at Any Show in the division entered.
- 5. TRAINING EQUIPMENT PERMITTED: Hackamores (bosal), snaffle bits and training aids (i.e., draw reins, running martingales, German martingales). No mechanical Hackmores allowed. Riders may use two hands on reins.
- 6. STALLIONS may not be shown by rider/handler who is under 18 years of age.
- 7. PARENTS/TRAINERS will supervise children and their mounts at all times.
- 8. PONIES allowed in all classes.
- 9. DOGS AND ALL OTHER PETS must be kept on a leash at all times.
- 10. CLASSES with less than three (3) entries may be canceled or combined.
- 11. Office Fee of \$15.00 shall apply to each back # issued. Separate Back # per each horse and rider combination required.
- 12. LEADLINE RIDERS -may not enter any other riding class.
- 13. WALK/TROT CLASSES entries in walk/trot classes OTHER THAN 10 & UNDER may enter other classes in the show.
- 14. ONE-MINUTE GATE RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.
- 15. COLOR CLASS Open to Appaloosa, Buckskins, Duns, Paints, Pintos, and Palominos. Excludes Bays, Greys, Blacks and Chestnuts.
- 16. CLASSIC HEAD CLASS Horse must wear unlettered sheet, blanket or cooler.
- 17. NON-COMPETITIVE RIDERS may enter any class at regular fee. Exhibitor number to be worn upside down on exhibitor's back.
- 18. Perpetual Trophies must show or submit a copy of registration papers.
- 19. For the safety of all, exhibitors will not be allowed to unhook trailers on the show grounds.
- 20. Manure from exhibitor's horses must be hauled home. Please leave your area clean.
- 21. HI-POINT MUST ENTER WITH INITIAL ENTRY FORM SUBMISSION AND PAY ADDITIONAL \$4.99 ENTRY FEE FOR HI-POINT FEE. SEPARATE ENTRY FORM AND OFFICE FEE REQUIRED FOR EVERY HORSE/RIDER COMBINATION.




